### Eucharistic Miracles Display

1 This section is the Eucharistic Miracles which occurred through the centuries and mainly consists of Hosts changing into flesh and bleeding as in Lancia-no and Santarem.  
2 This section shows the witness of the saints and mystics.  
3 The third section shows some of the Martyrs who gave their lives for the Eucharist and the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. There is an audio-visual presentation. There are many stories of **Eucharistic Miracles** throughout Church history that seem to confirm the important mystery of the Eucharist, Jesus Christ is really, truly, and substantially present in the **Eucharist**. The bread and wine used in the Mass become the body and blood of Jesus Christ. Pope Francis said reading accounts of **Eucharistic Miracles** is a great way to reinvigorate our belief and to encourage devotion to Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, in fact Jesus gives us these miracles throughout the centuries. Over the years, there have been many amazing Eucharistic **Miracles** that have left indelible impressions on individuals and communities. The Church has recognized more than one hundred **Eucharistic Miracles**, many of which occurred during times of weakened faith in transubstantiation. After a visit to the Display one will get a better understanding and enhancement of Faith in Jesus Christ.
