the local Community Games Area were in action on the athletic track at the
University of Limerick, competing in the National finals. For the local Area, they
took home a silver medal and 2 Medallions for fourth place, and others made it
all the way to the finals. Jack Forde (Crossabeg) was competing in the High Jump
and having scaled 1.86 the bar went up to 1.90 and here Jack had to bow out. A
very good silver medal for Jack. Ethan Jarvis (Crossabeg) qualified in second
place in the heat of the 60M under 8 and first in his semi final. He gave it his all
in the final and came home with the Medallion for finishing fourth in the final.
First time for Ethan to compete at this level. We hope to see plenty more from
him in the future. Billy Reck (Crossabeg) was our qualifier in the Under 16
Discus. He made it to the last 8 but finished outside of the medals. The boys
Under 14 Relay team were also in action. They qualified in second place in their
